· TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) · Internet-based test (iBT)	Score: 80

Credit Transfer

Students need to complete a minimum of 120 credits before graduation.

Holders of a recognized local sub-degree may be granted up to 60 advanced credits.

Local sub-degree holders can get a maximum of 60 advanced credits
(50% of total credits required for graduation)

- 9 University Common Core credits
- 12 unassigned free credits

DEPENDING ON SUBJECT ATTAINMENTS

- 6 credits in English communication
- 3 credits in Chinese communication
- Subject-specific transfer credits
